- Referee Points Points needed by each team to advance (If playoffs, fun-fest, or tournament play is applicable)







### **GAME FORMATS**

- 7/8U Vista Hermosa Sports Park or Forster (No Referee for 7U)
   6v6: Kick-ins (NOT Dribble-ins), No Throw-Ins, No Penalty Kicks, No Headers, No DFK's No Blocking the goal with a defender...
   Introducing Referee in 8U (New this season)
- 10U Forster 4 (1 Referee, 2 AR)
   7v7: No Headers, Build-Out Line, No Punting, Offside is Enforced
- 12U Forster 5 (1 Referee, 2 AR)
   9v9: No Headers, Punting Allowed, Offside is Enforced
- 14U / 16U / 19U Vista Hermosa Sports Park (1 Referee, 2 AR)
   11v11: Headers Allowed, Punting Allowed, Offside is Enforced

















## PITCH SIZE 5U/6U




- No Weekday Practices
- 25 mins practice before your game
- 5 min Quarters (4 Quarters) 5 min water break at half
- Substitution Rule: No player shall play 4 quarters until everyone has played 3
- Size 3 Soccer Ball
- 4v4 (6 Players on a Roster)
- Kick in (No Throw ins)
- Goal Kicks Attacking team must retreat to the center line
- No Corner Kicks
- No Score Keeping






## PITCH SIZE 7U/8U




- (1) Weekday Practice, 60 mins Max
- 10 min Quarters (4 Quarters) 5 min water break at half
- Size 3 Soccer Ball
- 6v6 (8 Players on a Roster)
- Substitution Rule: No player shall play 4 quarters until everyone has played 3
- Kick in (No Throw ins)
- Goal Kicks Attacking team must retreat to the center line
- Corner Kicks Stand 5 yards back
- Score Keeping (for Seeding)
- Coach Managed Refereeing (7U)
- Introducing 1 Center Referee in 8U


Simple, Earn a total of **5 REFEREE POINTS FOR YOUR TEAM**8U is the the youngest division with an Official Referee to manage the soccer game.

In order for your team to be eligible for the \$100 Gift Card, your team must complete the following steps...


- The team must have a minimum of one Affiliated Referee assigned the to team.
- The coach must let the Regional Referee Admin(RRA) know who the Affiliated Referee is for the team ASAP.
- The Volunteer Referee must complete all the courses needed to become a Certified Referee. Referee must be a Certified Referee for Referee Points to count for the team
- The team's Certified Referee or Referees need to earn a total of 5 Referee Points for the team. You earn at least 1 point for every game you sign-up for through Matchtrak and Referee.
- If you have completed all the requirements above, your team will earn \$100 Gift Card for your End of Season Pizza Party at Stuft Pizza in San Clemente.

\*Points earned during the Fall 2022 season can contribute towards the Referee Incentive Program for a seperate Gift Card. See Slide 22 for more details.








- Up to (2) Practices a week, 90 mins Max per practice
- 12.5 min Quarters (4 Quarters) 5 min water break at half
- Size 4 Soccer Ball
- Introduction of Goalkeeper (No Punting)
- Substitution Rule: No player shall play 4 quarters until everyone has played 3
- 7v7 includes Goalkeeper (10 Players Max on a Roster)
- Throw-ins
- Introduction of "Build out Line"
- Goal Kicks Attacking team must retreat to the build out line,
   players may attack once ball is passed or kicked
- Corner Kicks Stand 8 yards back
- Score Keeping is permitted
- Referee Points (1 Point per Game Played)
- Referees are Mandatory (1 Center, 2 Assistant Referees)
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place Medals awarded (based on record)
- Any team that obtains minimal referee points by the end of the Regular Season will qualify for Region Playoffs
- Winning team from playoffs will represent Region Division at the Area Tournament of Champions




- Up to (2) Practices a week, 90 mins Max per practice
- Water Breaks/Substitutions (midway through half, clock continues).
   Water Break/Substitutions at Half (clock stops)
- Size 4 Soccer Ball
- Teams have Goalkeepers, introduction of Punting
- 9v9 includes Goalkeeper (12 Players on a Roster)
- Substitution Rule: No player shall play 4 quarters until everyone has played 3 quarters
- Throw-ins
- NO Build-Out-Line
- Goal Kicks Attacking team must retreat outside Penalty Area,
   players may attack once ball is passed or kicked
- Corner Kicks Stand 8 yards back
- Score Keeping is permitted
- Referee Points (1 Point per Game Played)
- Referees are Mandatory (1 Center, 2 Assistant Referees)
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place Medals awarded (based on record)
- Any team that obtains minimal referee points by the end of the Regular Season will qualify for Region Playoffs
- Winning team from playoffs will represent Region Division at the Area Tournament of Champions





- 35 Min Halves (14U) 40 Min Halves (16U) 45 Min Halves (19U)
- Size 5 Soccer Ball
- 11v11 includes Goalkeeper
  - 15 Players on a Roster 14U, 18 Players on Roster 16/19U
- Substitution Rule
  - 14U No player shall play 4 quarters until everyone has played 3
  - 16U/19U Defer to Coach Admin
- Throw-ins
- Goal Kicks Attacking team must retreat outside Penalty Area,
   players may attack once ball is passed or kicked
- Corner Kicks Stand 8 yards back
- Score Keeping is permitted
- Referee Points (1 Point per Game Played)
- Referees are Mandatory (1 Center, 2 Assistant Referees)
- Minimal Referee points must be earned in order to participate in any Area Tournament



The referee's job is to be the official in charge of the game. A referee's authority extends to everyone at the field, including players, substitutes, team officials, spectators, and even assistant referees.

AYSO Referees keep the game safe, fair and fun for everyone: the players, the coaches, the spectators, and themselves!





## REFERES

### POINT SYSTEM (AYSO POST-SEASON PLAY)

Each Game Must Have a Referee or it is Subject to CANCELLATION

#### **U8 Referee Points**

Center Referees (Only) earn 1 points per game


#### **10U-14U Referee Points**

- Center Referees earn 2 points per game (U10-U14)
- Assistant Referees earn 1 point per game (U10-U14)

#### 16U and ABOVE Referee Points

- Center Referees earn 3 points per game (U16+)
- Assistant Referees earn 2 points per game (U16+)








# COACHES WITH AFFILIATE REFERS


### **SIGN UP PRIORITY**




## AYSO DOG POLICY

- Let dog owner know that the Park Monitor patrols regularly and the fine is substantial.









